Notice of Race

Rotary Club Mangalia, Yacht Club Sportiv Seanergya, Club Sportiv Electrica Balkan
is inviting you all to take part in the **Regatta Rotary Mangalia** to be held in Marina LifeHarbour - Limanu,
between 20th and 22nd of July, 2018.

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing
- 1.2. World Sailing Equipment Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 will apply.
- 1.3. World Sailing Offshore Special Regulations Appendix B, Special Regulations for Inshore Racing will apply
- 1.4. ORC Rating Rules will apply.
- 1.5. No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.6. The Official Languages of the Regatta is English and Romanian. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. By participating at the Regatta Rotary Mangalia a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authorities the right perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him/her, taken during the period of competition for the said Regatta Rotary Mangalia, in which the competitor participates and in all materials related, without compensation.

3. CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

As per request of the event organizers the boats shall facilitate the installation of video and/or sound equipment or cameras, provided by the organizers. This installation will not amend the certificates of the boats.

4. ADDITIONAL CREW

As per request of the event organizers the boats shall facilitate to carry one guest additional to their standard crew/guests. In absence of this request each boat can have one own guest additional to their standard crew. This will not amend the certificates of the boats and 5.6 will not apply for the extra person.

5. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 5.1. The Regatta is open to all keelboats. Boats will be divided in 2 (two) ORC classes considering ORC GPH as per Race Committee decision that shall be final. An Open class may be constituted for boats not willing to race under ORC rules. For the Open class, 5.5 and 5.6 will not apply.
- 5.2. Entries shall be made by filling-in the online Entry Form and the online Crew List provided by the Organising Authority no later than 19th of July, 2018. The links to these form are these:

- 5.3. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organizing authority.
- 5.4. To avoid the unnecessary use of paper, **no paper** documents shall be accepted for entries.
- 5.5. Entries shall be made only by a Romanian Yachting Federation (FRY) affiliated organization in good standing with FRY(annual tax paid to FRY) or a foreign organization in good standing with any World Sailing MNA. de ce?
- 5.6. All crew members should (this is not applicable to foreign crew member) be a member of an organization in good standing with FRY and should be personally in good standing with FRY (annual tax paid to FRY or provisional membership paid to FRY) and should have a medical clearance for sports for the competition period.

6. IDENTIFICATION

No registration numbers will be provided, boats name should be visible on the hull.

7. FEES

The entry fee is 50 RON/crew member will be collected at the regatta office.

8. SCHEDULE

- 8.1. Online Registration will be closed at 21:00 on 20th of July
 - 8.2. 20th of July, 21:00 Skippers meeting
 - 8.3. Dates of racing:
 - 21st of July, 11:55 First warning signal
 - 22nd of July 10:55 First warning signal
- 6 (six) inshore races are planned for the Regatta.

8.4. On 22nd of July, no warning signal will be given after 15:00, but to continue a general recalled race in progress.

8.5. Prize Giving & Closing Ceremony
22nd of July, as soon as possible

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be made available electronically to participants after registration.

10. VENUE

10.1. The Regatta Rotary Mangalia will be held in Marina LifeHarbour - Limanu.

10.2. The courses will be set in the Black Sea waters close to Mangalia.

11. THE COURSES

The sailing course will be announced in the Sailing Instructions with an enclosed drawing.

12. SCORING

12.1. The scoring system is as follows:

- The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A .
- Inshore races results will be determined by corrected times calculated by Inshore Triple-Number method.

12.2. For the Open Class no corrected times will be calculated.

12.3. 1 (one) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

12.4. When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

12.5. When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13. RADIO COMMUNICATION

13.1. Except in an emergency or if requested by the race committee, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13.2. The official communication channel of the race will be VHF channel 10.

13.3. VHF Chanel 16 is mandatory to be kept open at all times during the race.

14. Mooring

14.1. Boats may be placed in Marina LifeHarbour - Limanu, free of charge

14.2. Boats should not be lifted from the water during the regatta, unless there is a written consent from the race committee.

15. PRIZES

15.1. Cups and medals will be awarded to every boat placing first, second and third in each class and subclass.

15.2. The organising committee might award additional prizes at its discretion.

16. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority and any other party or person involved in the organisation of the event will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17. INSURANCE

It is recommended that all participating boats to be insured with valid third-party liability.
