



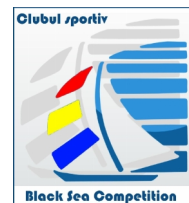

# NOTICE OF RACE

**Black Sea Sailing Association** in association with **C.S. Black Sea Competition, Clubul Nautic Roman** and **Fapt Sailing Club** is inviting you to take part in the **CALLATIS REGATTA (28<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup> of August)** which will take place in Marina Eforie. This Regatta is part of **Romania Cup 2015** and marks the end of the 4th edition of the traditional **Black Sea Sailing Trophy**.

## 1. RULES

- 1.1. CALLATIS REGATTA will be governed by the Rules as defined in the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2013 – 2016;
- 1.2. ISAF equipment rules of sailing 2013-2016;
- 1.3. ISAF offshore special regulation;
- 1.4. ORC rating rules;
- 1.5. The International regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (IRPCAS) will replace the rules of Part 2 of RRS from the actual sunset to the actual sunrise;
- 1.6. RYF (FRY) national authority prescriptions will not apply;
- 1.7. The Official Language of the Regatta is English and Romanian. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

## 2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority. All advertising materials should remain visible and posted according to Sailing Instructions, for the entire Regatta period.

## 3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1. Regatta is open to all sailing boats, providing a valid ORC rating certificate. The division of the boats will be divided according to the GPH value:
  - ORC Class A (Racers) -  $GPH \leq 670$
  - ORC Class B (Cruisers) -  $GPH > 670$ ,if minimum of 4 per each class.  
In a variation of max  $\pm 2\%$  from the value of  $GPH=670$ , participants can switch the category by written request to [blackseasailing@gmail.com](mailto:blackseasailing@gmail.com) and to [cristian.tabacu@gmail.com](mailto:cristian.tabacu@gmail.com)
- 3.2. The skipper must provide valid appropriate Sailing License.
- 3.3. **Non-spinnaker rating:** OA does not intend to be used in the same class non-spinnaker boats vs. spinnaker boats. These are intended to be used when all the boats in a start/fleet are racing without spinnakers.
- 3.4. In order for a boat to fulfill its entry status in the regatta, it must start at least one of the scheduled races.
- 3.5. The ORC Class A boats with ORC Club certificate will be eligible only if it were subject to displacement verification by weighing and sails & rig measurement.

## 4. ENTRY AND PROCEDURE

- 4.1. The entry form, completed in full, must be sent by email [blackseasailing@gmail.com](mailto:blackseasailing@gmail.com) and [cristian.tabacu@gmail.com](mailto:cristian.tabacu@gmail.com) until 27th of August 2015, 20:00.
- 4.2. Online entry application form must be accompanied by the crew list, a copy of valid ORC rating certificate of the boat, (released by a competent authority) and relevant Skipper's License.
- 4.3. There is no entry fee for the boats registered until 27th of August 2015, 20:00

4.4. Entries after the date above can be made at Race Office – Marina Eforie, but not later than 28th of August 2015, 19:00 (7:00pm). In this case an entry fee of 400 ron/boat will be applied.

4.5. Each owner or skipper should personally register (perform the entry) at the Race Office not later than 28th of August 2015, 19:00 (7:00pm);

4.6. Following documents must be presented at the entry procedure:

- valid ORC rating certificate
- boat registration certificate
- skipper license
- crew list
- declaration
- third party liability insurance of minimum 100.000 LEI

*It is the owner's or skipper's solely and inescapably responsibility to produce the above mentioned documents while making the entry. No modification will be accepted later than 9am on the first day of racing.*

## 5. MEASUREMENT

5.1. At any time through the series even whilst boats are racing, sails and boat shall be subject to scrutiny and to checks for compliance with the rules at the discretion of the Race Committee.

## 7. SCORING

7.1. Inshore race results will be determined by corrected times calculated by Triple-number method.

7.2. Offshore race results will be determined by corrected times calculated by Time-on-Time method.

7.3. The Low Point Scoring System of RSS Appendix A will apply.

7.4. Callatis Regatta is part of **Black Sea Sailing Trophy** and **Romania Cup 2015** and final results will be part of the general scoring

## 8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

8.1. Sailing Instructions will be available upon registration.

## 9. VENUE

9.1. The Race Office for Callatis Regatta will be in Marina Eforie

## 10. MOORING

11.1. All boat shall be placed at the assigned mooring place in Marina Eforie free of charge during the regatta.

## 11. RESTRICTIONS FOR LIFTING THE BOATS

12.1. Boats shall not be lifted from the water during the race, unless there is a written consent from the Race Committee.

## 12. COMMUNICATIONS

12.1. The official communication channel of the race will be announced through Sailing Instructions and at the Technical Meeting. **Channel VHF 16 is mandatory to be kept open at all times during the race.**

12.2. During races, no boat shall send or receive radio communications which are not available to all boats involved in competition. This restriction applies to mobile phones also.

## 13. PRIZES

13.1. Boats ranked first, second and third places will be awarded Callatis Regatta 2015 cups and medals.

## 14. LIABILITY

14.1 Competitors are racing in the regatta at their own will and risk (See ISAF RCV 2013-2016 rule 4, Decision to compete). Organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, their members or any other bodies or persons involved in organizing, conducting or judging the race, will accept no responsibility for material and personal losses, personal injuries or death occurred in connection with/or, before, during or after the regatta.

14.2 Each boat owner or his representative accepts these terms for themselves and for all the crew members, by signing the entry form.
